

EVIDENCE OF TEACHING EFFECTIVENESS

Quantitative and qualitative student evaluations on overall course and instructor ratings demonstrate strong and effective teaching performance. It is noteworthy that, across all classes, 99% of the students who completed teaching evaluations rated my teaching as “Excellent” or “Very Good.” For this, I have been recognized by the dean and my department at Florida State University. These scores provide evidence that students find my instruction in the courses I have taught well above average. In addition, students’ written comments demonstrate that students appreciate my enthusiasm, openness, knowledge of the subject, and ability to apply the material to everyday life.
